KEYNOTES:

Bruce Harvey (*Atlanta*) has devoted more than 30 years to criminal defense. His practice has taken him to both federal and state courts in more than twenty states and the U.S.

Virgin Islands. Bruce is known for the numerous high profile defendants he has represented, most recently Atlanta attorney Tex McGuyver, as well as many clients who attract less publicity. He has acted as lead counsel in a minimum of one pro bono death penalty case each year throughout his career. Bruce is a frequent lecturer and panel member in seminars on constitutional and criminal law throughout the country.

Bruce is a mentor for the Georgia Trial Skills Clinic and a judge for the annual National Mock Trial Competitions. For his work on death penalty cases, he has received the Thurgood Marshall Award presented by the New York State Bar. In 2008, He was selected as a member of the National Security Seminar at the Army War College in Carlisle, Pennsylvania. Named one of Georgia's Top Lawyers, Bruce also has achieved SuperLawyer status. He has been featured in Atlanta Magazine, the Atlanta Journal-Constitution, and was named one of Georgia's 100 Most Influential People by Georgia Trend Magazine. Bruce is a past president and life member of the GACDL.

Shannon Smith (*Michigan*) maintains a Michigan criminal defense practice devoted to representing individuals facing issues regarding sexual assault, sexual abuse and physical abuse. More than 90% of her cases involve cases where children are the alleged victims. Shannon is known on a national level for representing high-profile clients such as Dr. Larry Nassar and Dr. Jumana Nagarwala, the lead defendant in the first federal prosecution for female genital mutilation. Shannon's



cases are expert driven and frequently focus on issues such as child and adolescent development, memory and suggestibility and forensic interviewing techniques.

Shannon has been recognized by Super Lawyers every year since 2011. She is among the Top 100 Attorneys from the National Trial Lawyers Association and the Top 40 Lawyers Under 40 from the American Trial Lawyers Association. She is also a member of the Professional Advisory Board for a Useful Sex Offender Registry. Shannon also stays extremely busy spending time with her own children who are 4, 5, 7 and 8.

Philip Holloway (*Marietta*) has appeared on national news outlets such as CNN, HLN, NBC, MSNBC, Fox News, and is a trusted legal analyst for 11Alive in Atlanta, and CNN. He has an AV Preeminent rating amongst his peers, the highest rating accomplishment on the Martindale-Hubbell® PEER REVIEW RATINGS™.

Philip acted as guest commentator and legal expert on the internationally popular podcast "Up and Vanished." A true crime podcast, recorded in real time, "Up and Vanished" covered the disappearance of school teacher/beauty queen Tara Grinstead of Ocilla, GA. Tara mysteriously vanished without a trace back in 2005, and no one in the town seemed to know anything about it for 12 years... or did they?
